



SHIPPING/CUSTOMS

Exhibits and display material should be shipped PREPAID, addressed as follows;

Shipments should be scheduled to arrive on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, March 19 - 21, 2012 according to the scheduled move-in.

THE CMX-CIPHEX EXPOSITION WILL NOT ACCEPT COLLECT SHIPMENTS.

At the close of the show, where carriers fail to pick up or refuse to accept shipments, the drayage contractor reserves the right to reroute such shipments, where no disposition is provided. This material may be hauled to a warehouse pending advice from the exhibitor and the exhibitor will be charged accordingly for this service. No liability will be assumed as a result of such rerouting or handling.

Freight handling charges are the responsibility of the exhibitor to whom shipments have been consigned. Also, charges for loading-out of freight shipments are the responsibility of the exhibitor from whose booth shipments are made. Exhibitors may not assign this responsibility to suppliers or customers.

Neither the CMX-CIPHEX Show nor the MTCC shall be responsible for damage to uncrated materials, materials improperly packed or concealed damage. The CMX-CIPHEX Show or MTCC are not and cannot be responsible for loss or theft of exhibitor's materials. Security service is provided by the Exposition to help protect the exhibitor's property, ***but exhibitors must insure their own goods.*** All bills of lading covering shipments which are furnished to the exhibitors will be checked at time of actual loading and corrections made where discrepancies exist.

Neither, the CMX-CIPHEX Show or MTCC shall be responsible for loss, delay or damage due to strikes, lock-outs, or work stoppages of any kind. In order to expedite removal of materials, the CMX-CIPHEX Show shall have authority, without further clearance with exhibitors, to change designated carriers.

North American has been appointed the Official Transportation and Customs brokers for CMX- CIPHEX 2012. By using their Domestic or International Transport services for show displays, you will have these advantages:

- A) Free Advance Storage*** - of your goods in the Toronto warehouse prior to the show
- B) Door to Door Transportation Services** - International & domestic
- C) Canadian & US Customs Clearance** - in advance and onsite (their offices are in the building)

North American will have an on-site office for exhibitor's convenience. The Metro Toronto Convention Centre – North Building has been declared a bonded warehouse for the duration of the CMX- CIPHEX, thereby eliminating customs duties on display material and equipment imported for the show and returned to the country of origin after the show. While North American is the Official Customs Broker for the show, exhibitors may use any customs broker they wish. North American representatives will contact all exhibitors regarding their shipping and customs needs early in January.

SCHEDULING OF IN-BOUND SHIPMENTS

To facilitate the handling of exhibitor's goods, a schedule for unloading will be developed and a time assigned to your company. A time will be assigned to you, which will recognize your location and the amount of goods involved.
